Irvin A. and Agnes E. Nelson Fellowship Guidelines

The Nelson fellowship is a travel stipend to assist in the costs of travel for graduate students in any CASNR major who are presenting research or for training and professional development.

Guidelines

- 1. Student must be in a graduate program in CASNR.
- 2. Student must be involved in a research project(s) closely related to natural resource conservation, including, but not limited to soil, water, and wildlife (especially birds).
- 3. Academic achievement is a criterion.
- 4. Students shall also be judged on the basis of their potential for future promise for contributing to natural resource conservation, as judged by characteristics such as integrity, dependability, and perseverance.
- 5. Funds awarded should be used for travel expenses in attending a professional meeting for presentation of research results or professional development. This is a small fund and awards amounts are unlikely to cover full cost of trip. Once funds are awarded, amount will not be changed.
